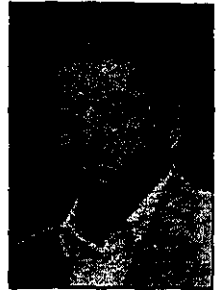

#### Profile

Seyed Hossein Mirjalili joined the Faculty of Economics at The Institute for Humanities in 1998. He was lecturer from 1998 to July 2001 and Assistant Professor from September 2001 to April 2006 and Associate Professor since May 2006.

Previously he was deputy director general of monetary and commercial policies at the Ministry of Finance and Economic Affairs in Iran (1991-1995). At the Institute for Humanities he was Director of international affairs (2000-2002), Vice Chancellor for academic affairs (2003-2004) and Dean of Faculty of Economics since 2005. He was advisor to plenipotentiary trade representative at the Ministry of Commerce in Iran during 2001-2006 as well. He is currently a Visiting Prof. at the University of Birmingham in UK.

He received national awards for; the book of the year (1995), one of the best doctoral dissertations of the year (2001) and one of the best researches on Islamic banking (2005). He serves as editorial board in: "Iranian Journal of Humanities", "(Arabic) journal of Horizons of thought and civilization", "Iranian economic journal" and "Iranian journal of world trade".

He has published 5 books mainly on money and banking and has several papers in proceedings of scientific conferences and academic journals.
